shall come to the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of *them* the said *Catherine*
Smith & Henry Smith —
or unto the Hands and Possession of any other Person or Persons for *them* and
the same so made do exhibit, or cause to be exhibited, into the Register's Office,
in the County of *Chester* — at or before the *Eleventh* Day of
February — next ensuing; and the same Goods, Chattels and Credits, and all
